We are delighted that you are considering Capesthorpe Hall for your wedding day celebrations. The staff at Capesthorpe are committed to supplying you with the best level of service to make sure that you have the most wonderful day of your lives.



If a civil wedding is required the maximum capacity is 80 guests, the Drawing Room is used for the ceremony and the Queen Anne Room for the wedding breakfast. The Saloon, which has doors opening onto the West Law Terrace, is used for drinks and canapés after the ceremony. Upstairs the exhibition rooms would be open, guests can wander around at their leisure. Outside there is a beautiful chapel where a wedding blessing can be performed.



If you are having a church wedding we can seat up to 140 guests in the Hall for the wedding breakfast. All the rooms mentioned above would be used and the grand Entrance Hall can be used to greet your guests on arrival.

For the evening the Lakeside Garden Terrace Room and Marquee would be used, in this area the guest numbers can increase to 150.





Every wedding at Capesthorpe is as individual as you are but includes the following as standard:

- ❖ Exclusive use of the Hall, to include the Entrance Hall, Queen Anne Room, Sculpture Gallery, Saloon and Drawing Room.
- ❖ Floral arrangements in the Hall (provided courtesy of Mrs Bromley-Davenport)
- ❖ Use of the State Dressing Room for final preparations by the bride and her bridesmaids.\*
- ❖ Access to the terrace overlooking the West Lawn for post ceremony drinks
- ❖ General viewing of first floor exhibition rooms giving your guests further insight into the history of Capesthorpe Hall.
- ❖ Capacity: Hall up to 80 for a Civil Marriage and Wedding Breakfast or 140 if reception only. Lakeside Garden Terrace Room and Marquee area for dancing - up to 150
- ❖ Beautiful Lakeside Evening Area (recently refurbished) including marquee overlooking lake for dancing (this area can be hired independently from the Hall midweek and some weekends subject to availability)
- ❖ Use of 100 acres of picturesque gardens, parkland and lakes for your wedding photographs
- ❖ Ample free car parking for all your guests
- ❖ Preferential discounted room rates at nearby hotels for you and your guests

A Civil Ceremony in the Hall can be followed by a Blessing in the private Family Chapel, by arrangement.

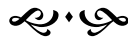

Terms & Conditions



**BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS**  
for Wedding Ceremonies, Receptions, Dinners and Private Parties  
held within Capesthorpe Hall

1. The **Host** to pay a non-returnable booking fee of £750 plus VAT to Capesthorpe H&G within 7 days of booking the event. In addition, the Host is also required to pay a returnable deposit of £300.00 to cover additional cleaning and/or damage costs, which may arise from the event.  
*\*Breach of paragraph 3 may result in this deposit being forfeited.*
2. The **Host** to pay 50% of the balance of agreed hire charge four months prior to event with the remainder to be paid in full one month before the event. All payments made are non-returnable in all instances.
3. The **Host** is at liberty to use any one of the recommended Caterers namely:
  1. *Barretts Event Caterers Limited*
  2. *Chapman Holmes*
  3. *Barkers Bespoke*for provision of all food and alcohol for consumption at the Event and to abide by the Caterer's own terms and conditions. **Hosts** are not at liberty to supply their own wines, Champagne, beers etc **CORKAGE IS NOT PERMITTED\***. Similarly, guests are not permitted to bring their own alcohol to the Event. There are no bar facilities available within the Main House.
4. At an Evening Reception the Garden Room Bar will close at 11pm prompt with 20 minutes only allowable for "drinking up" time. All musical entertainment must cease by 11:30pm and Guests must depart by midnight.
5. In the case of wedding events, the **Host** is to provide own table/flower decorations and seating plan for the Wedding Breakfast Room.
6. **Capesthorpe Hall** will provide the following services inclusive within the scales of agreed room hire charges:
  - i) Suitable floral arrangements within the Entrance Hall and Saloon.
  - ii) Changing facilities for Bride within the Yellow Dressing Room and this room is made available one hour before the Event.
  - iii) Exclusive use of Hall and access to the Gardens for the Event including the use of cloakrooms and services of stewards as appropriate.
7. The **Host** is to update Capesthorpe on all details of event including party numbers, arrival and departure times of guests, delivery of cake, wedding dress, flowers, entertainment, etc, at least two weeks prior to the event.

8. **Capesthorpe Hall** operates a **No Smoking Policy** within the Hall although smoking is allowed within the Grounds and Gardens. **All Hosts and guests must comply with this policy.**  
All children attending the Wedding Event must be supervised at all times and must not in any event, be allowed to play within the Gardens or Grounds unsupervised. Capesthorpe Stewards are not at liberty to child mind.
9. The **Host** is responsible at all times for the conduct of their guests, particularly in cases when excess alcohol consumption leads to unruly behaviour. Capesthorpe and the Caterer, reserve the right to restrict the serving of alcohol both in the House and on sale from the Garden Room bar to particular individuals and in rare cases also reserves the right to close the Garden Room bar completely.
10. **No Firework displays** are permitted at any private event.
11. **Capesthorpe** recommend **Hosts** to take out Insurance covering public liability and loss or damage to the property of Capesthorpe Hall and that of guests attending the Event – full details can be supplied.
12. **Capesthorpe** reserves the right to withhold the return of the £300 deposit in the event of serious breaches by the client or guests of the above Terms and Conditions.

There are certain limitations as to what can be permitted at Capesthorpe, due to the historical nature of the property, and clearance with the Hall Manager should always be ascertained before arranging anything unusual or out of the ordinary. For instance, chocolate fountains, stiletto heeled shoes and table candles are not permitted. Confetti (biodegradable) can be used but only on the West Lawn at the rear of the house.
